



Kiltha O'G Code of Behaviour 2017

All mentors, young members and their parents/guardians are expected to abide by the code of behaviour set out below

<p>1 For all Club members, players, Mentors, parents/guardians and supporters</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Promote the highest standard of personal conduct and fair play. b. Respect the right, dignity and worth of every person and treat each one equally. c. Do not use abusive language or harassing behaviour towards any player, mentor or official. d. Encourage players to abide by the rules and promote fair play. e. Condemn the use of violence and bullying in any form. 	<p>2 For Parents /guardians: Lead by example</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Ensure players arrive punctually for games and that pick-up arrangements are clear and that pick-ups are punctual. b. Impress upon players never to leave training grounds without informing a Mentor. c. Respect coaches/mentors/match officials at all times. d. Support the mentors in their roles if requested. e. Impress upon your children the code of behaviour that is expected. f. Inform the clubs Childrens Officer if you have a concern about your child's welfare. g. Inform mentors/coaches about any potential health issues (such as severe allergies) a child might have. h. If a child has a serious medical condition it is the parent's responsibility to attend fully all training sessions and matches.
<p>3 For the Players: Be safe and feel safe</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Respect and cooperate with mentors. b. Play fairly and enjoy yourself. c. Do not shout or use unacceptable language towards mentors, teammates or officials. d. Support fellow team members whether they do well or not. e. Take due care of Club equipment. f. Inform a mentor/coach if you have any problems or have been harmed in any way. 	<p>4 For Mentors/ Coaches : Be Role Models</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Ensure you have an understanding of relevant coaching methods. b. Respect the dignity, self-esteem and rights of all players. c. Be punctual and organised for training and games. d. Ensure all players are involved in training/games. e. Always be positive giving praise and encouragement. f. Clearly communicate matches/training times to players/parents. g. Be aware of club codes, policies and procedures. h. Make sure you have first aid available. i. Challenge unacceptable behaviour from players, mentors, parents
